

**Streets Committee Meeting
March 20, 2019 at Village Hall**

Meeting began at 7:00 with Mayor Lindeman, DJ Youngblood, Brett Shaw and Kay Kerr. Doug Nestor was excused. Guest: Greg Roehrich.

DJ Youngblood moved and Mayor Lindeman seconded a motion to approve February 19, 2019, minutes. Motion passed.

Discussions: Greg Roehrich requested the drain in front of 78 E Clinton be cleared. We will request a vac truck to jet drains in a few places soon. Legion drive on E Clinton needs attention. Lid beside PNC drive needs attention. Richwine on E Clinton needs drainage attention.

Equipment and supplies. Received new truck. Hydraulic line needs to be moved. Need to buy 100 ton of salt to finish old contract. Class for mosquito spraying is March 26. DJ Youngblood moved and Mayor Lindeman seconded a motion to buy 500 ton of salt for 19-20 winter season from State of Ohio contract bid process. Motion passed.

Superintendent's report.

Shade Tree is asking street department to plant 8 trees on Northwood, 3 trees on Sandstone Circle. It was decided May 6 is a good day to plant trees with school children.

Plan to crack seal Meadow Ridge and Hidden Pond this year.

Water line of 8 inches from N Portage to Midwest PolyPak (along Church St) is progressing. Asphalt will be installed soon.

Asked AMATS to perform a traffic count at all three schools. Waiting for them to schedule.

Will schedule storm drain work on Franklin, and 8 inch pipe on Huffman (Marion and go to Pond/Lepley houses) with new drains, repair catch basin on SW corner of 585 and Gates St, ask two companies to bid repair of storm drain on N Portage by post office alley, and re-establish drainage on SE corner of 585 and Gates St in 2019.

New pedestrian crossing sign ordered for N Portage St at a cost of \$280.

Next regular meeting is April 17, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. It was decided to move our meetings from third Tuesday of the month to third Wednesday in the future. Meeting closed at 7:55 p.m.
