RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE DOYLESTOWN RECREATION PROGRAM

1. The Doylestown Recreation Program shall operate from June 6th to July 15th, Monday, Wednesday and Friday, from 10:00 am to 12:00 Noon except for legal holidays. Times may vary based upon the travel time and programs involved on field trips. Should cancellation be required by the weather or other unforeseen circumstance, notification of cancellation shall be posted on the government channel 15 on Doylestown Cable and channel 1023 on Spectrum (Time Warner). 2. Participation is limited to residents of Doylestown and Chippewa Township between the ages of 6 and 13. Participants must be 6 years old by August 1st of the current year.
3. No one will be permitted to participate until a parent/legal guardian has completed a current registration form and paid the registration fee.
4. Registration Fees are as follows: Village residents \$40 per child, and \$35 per each additional sibling. Non-Village residents \$50 per child, and \$35 per each additional sibling. This price is all inclusive of activities, field trips crafts and snacks/ice cream on Fridays.
5. The registration fee is non-refundable after the first day of participation.
6. A parent/legal guardian and siblings may accompany the program on field trips and activities away from the Village Park provided that they provide their own transportation and all siblings must be accompanied by a parent. The Program Supervisors and employees will not supervise or be responsible for any sibling or parent accompanying the program.
7. Participants are expected to demonstrate appropriate behavior toward other participants, program employees and those they come in contact with during field trips.
8. A participant can be terminated from the program if in the opinion of the program Supervisor a participant engages in inappropriate behavior.
9. Participants are expected to attend the program from 10:00 am until 12:00 Noon. If it becomes necessary for a participant to leave early a signed note from a parent indicating the time the participant must leave shall be provided to the Program supervisor or the parent must pick up the participant and sign the participant out.

10. Participants shall ride the bus to and from all field trips. The Program Supervisor may permit at the request of the parent, the participant to accompany the parent in a private automobile. Said permission will only be granted upon evidence of necessity and the participant ceases to be under the care and supervision of the program while being transported in a private automobile.
11. Participants **must be signed in and out upon arrival and dismissal of the program each day**. If anyone other than the parent or guardian listed on the registration is to sign in or out the participant, it must be designated on the registration form including if the participant is permitted to sign him/her self in and out.
12. Any participant requiring the administration of medication deemed medically necessary by a doctor during the program must provide the medication to the Program Supervisor along with a completed administration of medication form signed by the parent. This applies to both over the counter medications and prescription medications.
13. If a participant should become ill or injured during participation in the program, the Program Supervisor shall attempt to notify the parent at the locations or phone numbers provided on the registration form. If the Program Supervisor deems it an emergency 911 will be called and paramedics dispatched. If it is determined that a hospital visit is necessitated and a parent is not present or has not been contacted, the participant will be transported to the hospital and accompanied by the Program Supervisor. Unless otherwise requested by the parent, necessitated by the location of the incident or nature of the injury, the participant will be transported to Akron Children's Hospital.
14. The Village of Doylestown and the Doylestown Recreation Program are not responsible for lost or stolen articles. It is strongly recommended that you do not bring any valuables to the program.
15. The Village Council, Park Board or Recreation Supervisor reserve the right to add, change or delete rules in accordance with our judgment to help maintain a safe environment for the participants and the activities.
16. All participants must wear socks and tennis shoes; sunscreen needs to be applied **prior to arrival** to the park.
