STREETS: NO REPORT. Next meeting April 1 at 5 PM at Village Hall which is a time change from the regular schedule.

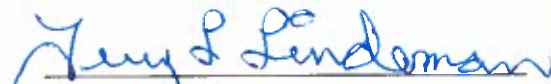

A Temporary (approximately 2-month) Mayor/Administrator Maps Advisory Committee is being convened to review and update the Village's official maps to ensure consistency with the actual location of Village assets, infrastructure, and other features, as well as with previously adopted and approved actions of Council, boards, committees, and commissions; Reminder, the Mayor and Village Admin are seeking applications for the Historic District Advisory Committee.
