Mr. Tony Lindeman led us in prayer, followed by the pledge of allegiance.

Roll Call: Mr. Brian Hessey, Mrs. Kay Kerr, Mr. Anthony Lindeman, Mrs. Joyce Marshall, Mr. Doug Nestor, and Mr. DeWayne Stout.

Mrs. Joyce Marshall made a motion to approve the minutes of April 17 with one correction, seconded by Mr. Doug Nestor. Roll Call: 5 ayes, 1 abstained – Mr. Tony Lindeman. He was not at that meeting.

#### EXECUTIVE REPORTS:

CLERK: Mr. Doug Nestor made a motion to place and pay bills in PO 7, seconded by Mrs. Kay Kerr. Roll Call: All ayes. RES. 2013-12 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN ODOT COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM. Mrs. Joyce Marshall made a motion to pass RES. 2013-12, seconded by Mr. Brian Hessey. Roll Call: All ayes.

MAYOR: Mrs. Kay Kerr made a motion to approve the April Mayor's Court report, seconded by Mrs. Joyce Marshall. Roll Call: All ayes. Second Reading of ORD. 2013-11 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2007-09 WHICH IMPLEMENTED SECTIONS 3735-65 THROUGH 3735-70 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, BY ESTABLISHING THE DOYLESTOWN COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AREA AND DESIGNATING A HOUSING OFFICER TO ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM AND CREATING A COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT HOUSING COUNCIL AND A TAX INCENTIVES REVIEW COUNCIL. Mrs. Kay Kerr made a motion to read by title only, seconded by Mrs. Joyce Marshall. Roll Call: All ayes. It was then read by title only.
