Mrs. Joyce Marshall made a motion to have Longfellow Home Improvements put a new roof on Pavilion 2 at a cost of \$4,054.00, seconded by Mr. Doug Nestor. Roll Call: 5 ayes, Mrs. Kay Kerr abstained because of a possible conflict. They are looking into a fence replacement program in 2014. We need to verify our property lines. They want to refinish the sign at Gates St. and S.R. 585. The electric needs to be disconnected before disassembling. The Park Board preferred a likeness to the Northwood sign.

PLANNING COMMISSION: Next meeting is November 14 at 7:30. They are working on a way to deal with the trash violators.
