

Streets Committee Meeting

December 20, 2022

Present: Mayor Lindeman, DJ Youngblood, CJ Gadosik, Jamie Ivy & Kay Kerr. Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. Meeting ended at 6:41. Next meeting: January 25, 2023.

Truck Bed Bid-Jamie will review, PO will be done on Jan 2, 2023, to lock in the price. DJ and CJ moved and seconded a motion to accept the ACC Truck Equipment bid for the bed and associated equipment after Jamie reviews details. Motion passed. The basic truck is scheduled to arrive in February 2023.

Jamie reports 1900 yards of leaves were picked up this year. It is a little less than last year. Leaf pickup were finished on schedule. Jamie and Sean worked on trucks to get ready for next season, fixed wheels and have a backup plow for snow. The scrap metal sold for between \$1,500 and 1,600. An ongoing project will be drains and street signs.

The Gates Street project is looking to be a 1.3 million dollar project. Engineering can start in Jan and bids can be later this year. The state is expected to grant the project \$500,000 and a \$250,000 interest free loan. Remaining money comes from other sources. This work will separate the sanitary sewer, gas, storm drain and water lines. And it could take some months to finish.

It was discussed that no parking signs need to be posted on Franklin Drive after the road is repaired and post no parking sign on side of Portage to Maple Street.
