

## Streets Committee Meeting

January 25, 2023

Present: Mayor Lindeman, CJ Gadosik, Jamie Ivy & Kay Kerr. Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m.  
Meeting ended at 7:15 p.m. Meeting was held at the street garage. Next meeting: February 22, 2023.

Crack Seal: Need to measure and see how far \$10,000 will go to crack seal streets like Vineyard, Melody Lane to new pavement, Meadow Ridge, Hidden Pond, Juniper Path, Sandstone Circle, Willow Way, Wild Cherry Lane and Stone Ridge Circle.

Mayor, Jamie and CJ will look at Franklin Dr berm and make a decision of how to fit new paving to berm.

CJ applied for a grant for paving funding for the Thriving Community program. Waiting for an answer.

Looking at possible need to replace pole holding traffic light at Marion and N Portage St.

Jamie was asked to look at initial specs for retaining wall on Ridge Top and ask a contractor what the solutions could be for the leaning wall.

It is estimated that we still have 300 ton of salt left to be delivered.

Chip and seal: Need to measure and get price for Valley View, Gates St Ext, W Marion, Howard and Brooklyn.

Jamie is looking at cost of no parking signs. Jamie was asked to call for truck delivery information.

Jamie called for a street sweeping cost. He has called several times so Mayor will call to ask for prices. The plan is to sweep all curbed streets before Memorial Day and N and S Portage Street (the curbed part in the incorporated area) one more time after the festival.

Look at Maple St from S Portage to corner of Maple and Franklin. Need some more pipe and maybe storm drains.

Leaf removal company coming the week of Jan 30 to remove leaves.

Jamie was asked to call a few fuel supply places to compare prices for the future.

We will ask the American Legion to buy flags and poles so that they are in place before Memorial Day.

CJ and Mayor moved and seconded a motion to approve the December 20, 2022, minutes as presented.
