The regular meeting of the Doylestown Village Council was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Terry Lindeman.

Mr. Mark Hammer led us in prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Mr. CJ Gadosik, Mr. Mark Hammer, Mrs. Kay Kerr, Mr. Tim Smith and Mr. DJ Youngblood.

Mr. DJ Youngblood made a motion to excuse Councilman Doug Nestor, seconded by Mr. Mark Hammer. Roll Call: All ayes.

Mr. Mark Hammer made a motion to approve the Council minutes from March 1, 2023 seconded by Mrs. Kay Kerr. Roll Call: All ayes.

VISITORS ON THE AGENDA: Erica Case and Kyle Schafrath. Both were here to ask Council to consider the passage of legislation prohibiting Drag and Adult Entertainment in public areas where it could be viewed by a person who is not an adult, for example the library, park, school. Mr. DJ Youngblood stated that this is a very gray area and we would have to do legal research on this topic.

SHADE TREE: NO REPORT. Next meeting April 3 at 7 PM.


STREETS: New Freightliner truck arrived and is currently getting outfitted. Next meeting March 22 at 6 PM. Meeting will be held at the street garage.
