Mrs. Kay Kerr made a motion to approve the Council minutes from April 5, 2023 seconded by Mr. CJ Gadosik. Roll Call: 5 ayes; 1 abstain – Mr. Doug Nestor as he was not at that meeting.

Roll Call: All ayes. **ORD. 2023-11 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE EXISTING SECTION 1155.11 BD DOWNTOWN BUSINESS DISTRICT BY ADDING THE SUBSECTION (F) USES PROHIBITED IN CHAPTER 1155 IN PART ELEVEN, TITLE THREE OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING CODE.** Third reading. **STREETS: NO REPORT.** Next meeting May 10 at 6 PM. Meeting will be held at the street garage.

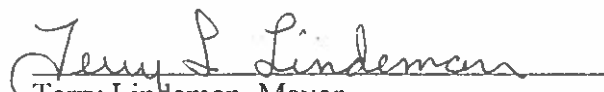
