SUBJECT OF MEETING:

The Doylestown Village Council met and held a public hearing on a proposed zoning map amendment for property owned by Cottage Floral LTD., located at 197 Collier Drive Doylestown, Ohio 44230 and also referred to as Permanent Parcel No. 17-01075.000. The property to be rezoned consists of 1.4 acres. The applicant is requesting a zoning change from the current IL Light Industrial to BD Downtown Business District classification.
