- Mr. Smerigan and myself met with School Superintendent and Treasurer about sign on press box. Hoping to come up with an amicable solution for all parties involved.
- I attended the OML Conference October 18-20, 2023. Very informative. I thank Mayor and Council for providing the opportunity for me to attend.

SAFETY

- Safety met on October 18, 2023. Vehicles. Decals. #8563 is ready to sell but has multiple issues. Working on selling it "As Is". Snollygoster Parade was held on October 26, 2023. All was a success.
- Nate nominated for Special Olympics. Congrats on being one of the Guardian Award Nominees at Awards Banquet to be held on November 17, 2023 in Columbus.
- Dispatch contract was dropped off at County Commissioners Office. The amount was \$14,890 (4% increase) Contract spells out increases through 2028.

WATER DISTRIBUTION

- 10-17-2023: Central Painting & Sandblasting performed interior and exterior inspection of the 800,000 gallon water tower located on Hill Top Dr.
- 10-23-2023: Water main break discovered and repaired. Located at 213 E. Marion St.
- 10-27-2023: Received 800,000 water tower inspection report from Central Painting & Sandblasting. The report was good. Interior liner declared to be in good shape, with no obvious concerns. Exterior liner showing minor signs of wear. Nothing of major concern.

SEWER PLANT

- 10-24-2023: Agri-Sludge on site, pressing sludge for Doylestown WWTP and the sludge of a local trailer park. Doylestown will receive a check from Agri-Sludge for being allowed to press trailer park sludge at the Doylestown WWTP. Amount to be determined after pressing is completed.
- 10-31-2023: Doylestown Utilities Dept along with Stanley Miller Construction and Dynamerican vac truck company, replaced pump bases at the Hidden Pond wastewater pump station.
- Water & Sewer Committee-Raise grinder pump assessment 50%. Bill will go from 20.48 a month to 30.72 a month. Will review contract to see if other issues need to be addressed.
