Mr. Tony Lindeman made a motion to excuse Mr. Chad Marti, seconded by Mr. Doug Nestor. Roll Call: All ayes.

Mr. Doug Nestor made a motion to approve the minutes of April 2, seconded by Mrs. Courtney Dannemiller. Roll Call: 4 ayes, 1 abstained – Mr. Tony Lindeman. He was not present at that meeting.

VISITORS ON THE AGENDA: Todd Chrislip and Laurie Strauss were here asking for permission to erect a fence that would encroach on the Village right-of-way.
