



# Water and Sewer Department Committee Meeting Minutes

This is the quarterly meeting of the Village of Doylestown Water and Sewer Committee held on 1/25/2024.

In attendance: committee members Terry Lindeman, and Mark Hammer.  
Also, present Utility Manager Mark Lightner.

The minutes, of the 10/26/2023 meeting, were approved by email after the meeting.

Mark Hammer requested that, by the next meeting in April, Mark Lightner have a priority list of wants, and needs and would be nice to have; as well as an inventory of all assets the water and sewer department owns. He requested Mark evaluate these assets and decide what is needed and not needed. Mark also stated that the Lockhart pump station upgrade be moved up the priority list.

Mark Lightner reported the high service pump was quoted by Mark Karl at \$14,100. NWS's quote was \$20,000. The sand bed replacement is being quoted. Options are still being explored for the use of the underground storage room at the main sewer building for bulk chemical storage.

The mayor mentioned there needs to be a collaboration of all departments because the Lockhart development and the Gates St construction will be going on at the same time.
