Patrolman's salary to increase in order to meet current market situation.

- Part time officers pay to start at \$18 and cap at \$25
- First time officers to start at \$27
- Nate and Frank to receive a raise to \$29

A reduction in the tax forgiveness will result in the following increases in revenue

- Forgive 1.5% will increase by \$150,000
- Forgive 1% will increase by \$300,000

Executive session in order to discuss the tax forgiveness

DJ motion to change the tax forgiveness from 2% to 1% 2nd Mark Hammer

DJ motion to accept the bid to remove the mausoleum at Chestnut hill for a total of \$2200, 2nd Mark Hammer

DJ motion to raise the flat rate for grave opening and closing to \$1200 with no weekends or Holiday's, 2nd Mark Hammer

Bid for the construction of a pavilion at Chestnut Hill Cemetery comes in at \$314,359. Pavilion to be 20x28. Cemetery board is working on an estimate for Cedar as well.

Terry made motion to get pricing on all these improvements including a parking area, 2nd Mark Hammer.

Kim Ferenz stated that Casey Tester would like to carryover 24 days of vacation. DJ made motion to allow it, 2nd Mark Hammer

DJ made a motion to purchase and install a new water fountain at the Village Hall, 2nd Mark Hammer
