

On June 7, 2006 at 8:00 P.M. the Chestnut Hill Cemetery Board met at the home of Dave Monbarren, 132 Cleveland Rd. Doylestown, Ohio.

Members present were: Dave Monbarren, Ag Monbarren, Dave Polland, Kay Dyer and Councilman Joseph Barr.

The meeting was called to adopt rules and regulations governing grave cites at the cemetery.

The following rules and regulations were adopted to insure the sanctity, respect and reverence that all grave cites deserve.

#### Chestnut Hill Cemetery Rules and Regulations:

1. No wreaths or plastic flowers will be left on the grave cites during mowing season. Plastic flowers may be left on the grave cites from November 1, through April 15, after which they will be discarded.
2. No pots or glass containers are to be left on the grave cites at anytime.
3. No shrubs, trees or bushes will be planted or left on the grave cites.
4. No external shepherd hooks, stands, statuary items, or knick knacks shall be left on the grave cites.
5. No flags larger than a staff of 24" high, with no flag larger then 22' x 16" in width and length.
6. Live planting and solar lights may be used within 1 ft. of the front of the headstone.
7. Should any monument, marker, effigy, decoration, ornament, enclosure, planting or other object or structure be erected, or placed in, around or upon any lot which the Trustees may deem improper, injurious or unsightly, it may cause the same to be removed.
8. Any additional or second monument on a grave must be ground level.
9. No more than 2 cremains on a single grave, or one regular burial and one cremains.
