The minutes of the April meeting had been sent via e-mail to all members before the May meeting, which was cancelled due to no business before the Board.

Due to the vacation of the Village zoning inspector, the weed and trash ordinance update was not brought to the Board. It was noted by the mayor that there are hardly any repeat trash violators. However, the weed and grass mowing is becoming a problem due to 12-14 empty properties in the village.

Utility Box upkeep: The cable companies report that they do not have to keep the boxes in good repair. David Watkins made a motion that the Village Solicitor send a letter to the Cable companies, citing a court case in Keenton, Ohio, that ruled that utility companies are required to keep their properties in good repair. Olin Bleichrodt seconded the motion.
Motion Approved.

A list of permits was sent to the Board. There were 3 new home permits in the last 3 months.

A discussion about all the lawn mowing companies working in the Village brought up the need for the Engineer to research who and how do we control the permits and fee collections.

Proposed cost to repair the storm sewer outfall at the wastewater treatment plant was presented. Due to the heavy rains, there was damage to this outfall. Budget restraints will mandate repairing this at the lowest and best cost.
