The regular meeting of the Doylestown Village Council was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Terry Lindeman.

Mr. Tim Smith led us in prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Mr. CJ Gadosik, Mr. Mark Hammer, Mr. Doug Nestor, Mr. Harold Rozak, Mr. Tim Smith and Mr. DJ Youngblood.

Mr. Tim Smith made a motion to approve the Council minutes from October 2, 2024 seconded by Mr. Harold Rozak. Roll Call: All ayes.

EXECUTIVE REPORTS:

CLERK: Mr. Tim Smith made a motion to place and pay bills in PO #18, seconded by Mr. Harold Rozak. Roll Call: All ayes. Mr. Tim Smith made a motion to approve the September 2024 Financial Reports, seconded by Mr. CJ Gadosik. Roll Call: All ayes. **ORD. 2024-30 AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A SIX (6) MONTH MORATORIUM ON THE ACCEPTANCE, CONSIDERATION AND/OR GRANTING OF ANY APPLICATIONS FOR LOCAL LICENSING APPROVAL, AND/OR ANY ZONING, OCCUPANCY, OR OTHER PERMITS RELATING TO CULTIVATORS, PROCESSORS OR RETAIL DISPENSARIES OF MARIJUANA WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF DOYLESTOWN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.** After the first reading, Mr. Mark Hammer made a motion to suspend the rules and have the second and third readings by title only, seconded by Mr. Harold Rozak. Roll Call: All ayes. After the readings, Mr. Mark Hammer made a motion to pass ORD. 2024-30 seconded by Mr. Harold Rozak. Mr. DJ Youngblood wanted to verify that this would not allow this type of business in the Village if this passed, and Mr. Mark Hammer answered only for six months until Planning could properly discuss this. Mr. Doug Nestor asked the Solicitor if Section Three would allow state law to be followed, the Solicitor answered yes. Roll Call: Mr. Mark Hammer, Mr. Harold Rozak and Mr. Doug Nestor, yes. Mr. CJ Gadosik, Mr. Tim Smith and Mr. DJ Youngblood, no. Mayor Lindeman broke the tie with a yes vote. Kristen reported that Dynegy Energy Services, East purchased Energy Harbor. Nothing will change with our electric aggregation, and residents should be getting a mailing with this information. Kristen will be attending a CPIM Conference held by the Treasurer of State in Columbus on October 24.


Mr. CJ Gadosik made a motion to adjourn at 7:11 PM seconded by Mr. DJ Youngblood. All Ayes.
