1. K9 Cruiser Transfer to SRO – Update

- Newton anticipates a transfer timeline around September.

2. Soliciting in the Village – Discussion

- There has been an increase in resident complaints regarding solicitors.
- Note: While a complete ban is not enforceable, restrictions are permitted.
- The council should consider implementing restrictions including:
 - A licensing fee,
 - Background check requirements as outlined in the ordinance, and
 - Health documentation requirements (e.g., a doctor's note) with associated fees set by the charter.
- Decision-making authority for these matters should rest with Christina or her designee, rather than Joyce.
- **Ordinance Highlight:** The ordinance specifies that properties should display a "No Soliciting" sign. This signage could potentially be included in new resident welcome packets or even offered for sale to citizens.
