The regular meeting of the Doylestown Village Council was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Terry Lindeman.

Mr. Mark Hammer led us in prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Mr. CJ Gadosik, Mr. Mark Hammer, Mr. Doug Nestor, Mr. Harold Rozak, Mr. Tim Smith and Mr. DJ Youngblood.

Mr. Mark Hammer made a motion to excuse Kristen Robison, Clerk of Council, seconded by Mr. Tim Smith. Roll Call: All ayes.

Mr. Tim Smith made a motion to approve the Council minutes from September 17, 2025 and September 25, 2025 seconded by Mr. CJ Gadosik. Roll Call: 5 ayes 1 abstain. Mr. Doug Nestor was not at those meetings.

From September 3rd to 30th, our Facebook page had over 5,600 views and reached about 3,000 unique people — the majority from outside our follower base. We logged 23 interactions and grew to 180 followers with no unfollows. If Council would like, we can provide these analytics monthly.

Our YouTube channel is also set up with folders for Council, Committees, Boards, and Commissions, and will be ready to pilot once the camera system is installed.


On the camera system, we are gathering four estimates. The system will cover Council, the Mayor, Solicitor, Clerk, and projector, integrate with our existing audio, and require minimal real-time management. It remains on track for completion this quarter.

In short: Facebook is live and working well, YouTube is ready to go, and the camera project is moving forward. Tonight is just for information, with optional feedback from Council on how often you'd like to see analytics reports.
