  - Earl to get Answers on upkeep, Maintenance, etc
  - Harold reported on Breaksville’s Safety Town.
    - NOTE: It was Fenced In - that does not set well with the Public
- Trim Bandstand & Gazebo Roof with lights – Street dept to Install
  - **Decided to Only Light Up Gazebo this year**
  - **Get Input from Downtown Businesses as to Lighting up Buildings**

### PARK FUND RAISER (Target \$160k - \$120k needed (45k in Budget)

- Priorities: #1 Restrooms \$60k / #2 Walkway \$17-28k / #3 Security Cameras \$35k
- Discussed Moving Target for Completion to Early 2026
  - Continue Getting Costs and Donation thru Winter
  - Gift Card Drive thru Raise Right - Village Receives (20%)
  - Solicit Township, Lions, Legion, Businesses, Individuals
- **T-Mobile \$50k Grant**
  - **Need 5 Letters of Support from Community**
