

Doylestown Shade Tree Committee

July 13, 2015

Courtney called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M. Other members present were Andy and Chris.

The committee reviewed the list for trimming and removal.

Andy wants an arborist to look at the tree by the bandstand to determine the best way to handle that. The homeowner does not want it removed. But the town must consider the cost of continues trimming and it's condition for safety reasons.

The tree at 444 High and 468 N. Portage need removed. He wasn't able to find the trees at 649-695 N. Portage.

The street crew will remove smaller trees. Andy will have the list updated for the next meeting.

A letter was supposed to be sent to Benny Murawski stating he needed to trim the limb over the road, but Andy said the whole tree needs to come down.

Marguerite Halliwell asked Chris about the tree in between her home and Rick Porters old home. She said it has had removal marks on it a couple of times. Chris told her they were probably trim markings and not removal, but we would look into it.

Courtney said the proposal presented to council for the new home tree assessment was accepted.

Numerous homes in the Valley View Development have requested trees. Ten Ash trees were planted on Northwood.

A tree was hit on E. Clinton Street. Zuks (?) Tree Co. gave a quote of \$1900.00 for the removal and replacement of the Red Sunset Maple. This is to be covered by the insurance company.
