Jet is receiving training at O.G. Ohio Hundsport of Dalton owned by John Nussbaum and Zack Nussbasum. Doylestown will be responsible for the care of the dog.
- The DPD is in need of some new body cameras. The cost is around \$299 each. The total cost around \$1188. The department would like to use Capital dollars for the purchase. PPF Chair, Courtney Dannemiller gave the permission to proceed with the purchase.
