

Doylestown Shade Tree Committee
July 18, 2016
6:30 P.M.

Kay called the meeting to order. Members present were Kay, Andy, Terry, Jerry and Chris.

The minutes from the April and June meetings were read and approved.

The committee has an \$8,000.00 budget this year. At this time \$1235.00 has been used.

Three trees have been lost on Briarwood.

The committee reviewed the right of way for several streets. Terry mentioned that most of the new developments have a 60' right of way.

A letter was received from a homeowner on Homan Dr. asking for the committee to send a letter to a neighbor regarding a dead tree. They expressed their concern about it falling in an area where kids play.

The town has received one price for the removal of 3 trees in a wooded area off of Northwood, and Gates Street. Hercules Tree service quoted \$1200.00. Terry stated that in 1991 an agreement was made that Doylestown would be responsible for the upkeep/maintenance of this area. Terry said this amount would come out of the budget we are given from the state. The trees will be marked for removal.

At 7:05 the committee drove around town reviewing trees that have sustained damage from numerous sources. (Sun burn, vehicles, wind, ECT.)

The committee finished up at 8:56, and was treated to an ice cream delight by Kay.
