Kay called the meeting to order. Other members present were Terry, Andy, Jerry and Chris.

The minutes were read and Terry made the motion to accept the minutes, Andy second and the minutes were approved.

Kay expressed her concern about the recently planted Crab Apple Trees on Stone Ridge Circle. It was suggested that they could be trimmed up in the winter when possibly the street crew would have some time.

Irish Silk Lilacs were recommended for Juniper Path.

A tree on the corner of N. Portage and Cleveland needs looked at. The house it is near faces N. Portage.

473 N. Portage and Pine Lane have a tree with limbs down and a large hole in it. Andy was asked to look at this tree.

Letters will be sent out to the following tree removal companies asking for bids. Barnett, Hercules, Linger, Barberton, and Simmons.

Jerry has been working on the inventory of our trees. The type, location, and size (circumference) of the trees will be the initial input. Eventually it will be our guide for tracking the upkeep and maintenance cost of each tree.

A Howard Street resident had inquired about the committee stepping in regarding a neighbor's tree they were concerned with. Doylestown's solicitor stated it was a civil matter.
