**SUBJECT OF MEETING:**

The Doylestown Village Council will meet and hold a public hearing on a proposed zoning map amendment for property owned by Main Way Markets, Inc. located at 105 Collier Drive Doylestown, Ohio 44230 and also referred to as Permanent Parcel No. 17-00237.000. The property to be rezoned consists of 1.88 acres. The applicant is requesting a zoning change from the current BD Downtown Business District classification to IL Light Industrial District.
