Meeting began at 7:00 with Mayor Lindeman, Doug Nestor, DJ Youngblood, Brett Shaw and Kay Kerr.

Citizens commented on sidewalks on Howard St and Meadow Ridge Trail. Citizen complimented storm drain work done between Pine Lane and Summit St.

We reviewed a possible list of roads for bid process to apply a level coat and chip seal for 2019. Doug Nestor moved and DJ Youngblood seconded a motion to request permission to seek bids for 2019 chip and seal work. Motion passed.

Equipment and supplies-cut off ^{saw} needs replaced and could cost \$2,000. Need mosquito spray this year and it could be \$1,500. Need 36 inch pipe and it could cost \$4,000.

Lighting at Maple/Franklin and South Portage was discussed. Mayor is to ask Edison to replace bulb in street light to make the area brighter. Times are posted on signs for lower speed limit from 7 to 4 p.m. on school days. For safe routes to school program, let's add Maple and Franklin.

Will need catch basins on Maple and Franklin and 8 inch pipe on Huffman with new drains in 2019.

Will need another leaf pick up in spring.

EPA has given us new regulations requiring paper work and monthly inspections.

DJ Youngblood moved and Terry Lindeman seconded a motion to accept October 16, 2018, minutes. Motion passed.
