SHADE TREE: Met March 1 working on their annual plan, welcomed CJ Gadosick to committee. Next meeting April 5 at 7 PM.

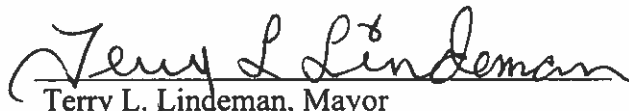
