The Village of Doylestown is committed to protecting the privacy of our residents and visitors. This Privacy Policy outlines how we collect, use, and safeguard information obtained through our official website and related services.

1. Information We Collect

- **Personal Information:** We collect personal information (such as name, address, email, and phone number) only when voluntarily provided by users through forms, emails, or other direct communications.
- **Non-Personal Information:** We may collect non-identifiable information such as browser type, operating system, IP address, and pages visited to analyze website traffic and improve user experience.

2. Use of Information

The information collected is used to:

- Respond to inquiries and provide requested services.
- Improve website functionality and user experience.
- Communicate important information, alerts, and updates.
- Comply with legal obligations and public records requests.

3. Sharing of Information

We do not sell or rent personal information to third parties. Information may be shared with third-party service providers who assist in operating our website and conducting Village business, provided they agree to keep this information confidential. Additionally, information may be disclosed when required by law, including compliance with the Ohio Public Records Act.

4. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

Our website may use cookies to enhance user experience. Users can choose to set their web browser to refuse cookies or alert when cookies are being sent. Note that some parts of the website may not function properly without cookies.

5. Data Security

We implement appropriate security measures to protect against unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction of personal information. However, no internet transmission is entirely secure, and users should exercise caution when submitting personal information online.

Our website may contain links to external sites not operated by the Village of Doylestown. We are not responsible for the content or privacy practices of these sites and encourage users to review their privacy policies.
