## RESOLUTION 2026-03

### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY UNNEEDED, OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES BY INTERNET AUCTION SALE

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes that the use of internet sites to auction municipal property that is no longer needed, is obsolete or is unfit for municipal purposes is an expedient, efficient and inexpensive method of sale; and

WHEREAS, Section 721.15 of the Ohio Revised Code requires an annual resolution by the legislative authority to authorize the sale of municipal property by internet auction.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Doylestown, State of Ohio, resolves that:

SECTION 1: The Council authorizes the sale by internet auction of municipal property that is no longer needed, is obsolete or is unfit for municipal purposes during calendar year 2026. For any property which the Administrator has determined has no resale value, the Administrator is authorized to discard or salvage such property without auction.

SECTION 2: The Council authorizes the Administrator to either conduct the internet auction or contract with one or more internet auction websites, which shall establish the general terms and conditions of sale consistent with this resolution and §721.15 O.R.C.

SECTION 3: The number of days for bidding on the property offered for sale shall be at least 10 days including Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays.

SECTION 4: The Clerk of Council shall cause notice of this resolution to be published on the Village website, which notice shall be prepared and published in the format of legislation summaries.

SECTION 5: The Clerk shall also cause the notice to be posted continuously throughout the calendar year in Village Hall and the Village of Doylestown website.

SECTION 6: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
