## RESOLUTION 2026-06

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE EXPEDITED TYPE II ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF DOYLESTOWN, PROVIDING THE REQUIRED MUNICIPAL SERVICES PLAN PURSUANT TO ORC 709.023, AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO REPRESENT THE VILLAGE FOR ALL RELATED PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the owners of certain real property located in Chippewa Township, Wayne County, Ohio, contiguous to the Village of Doylestown, have filed or intend to file a petition for Expedited Type II Annexation under Ohio Revised Code § 709.023; and

WHEREAS, ORC § 709.023 requires the municipal corporation proposed to receive the territory to adopt a resolution stating whether it supports or objects to the annexation, and to provide a municipal services plan describing the services that will be extended to the area; and

WHEREAS, Village Council finds that the proposed annexation is consistent with the long-term land use, service-delivery, and community-development interests of the Village of Doylestown; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the Village Administrator to represent the Village, communicate with the County Commissioners, and transmit all necessary documents related to this annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Doylestown, Wayne County, Ohio

SECTION 1: The Village of Doylestown hereby supports the Expedited Type II annexation of the territory described in the petition submitted by the property owner(s), consisting of approximately 1.719 acres, being permanent parcel number(s) 12-02477.001, and contiguous to the Village.

SECTION 2: Pursuant to ORC § 709.023(E), the Village will provide municipal services to the annexed territory as follows:

- **Police Protection:** Full police services provided by the Doylestown Police Department upon the effective date of annexation.
- **Fire/EMS:** Fire and EMS services will continue to be provided through existing mutual-aid and contractual arrangements.
- **Water Service:** Water service will be made available consistent with Village regulations, capacity, and utility connection requirements.
- **Sanitary Sewer:** Sewer service will be provided consistent with the Village Wastewater Treatment Plant capacity, connection policies, and extension requirements.
- **Street Maintenance:** Maintenance of dedicated public streets within the annexed area will commence upon acceptance and dedication by the Village.
- **Zoning and Code Enforcement:** Full enforcement of the Village Zoning Code, Property Maintenance Code, and General Offenses Code will apply upon annexation.
- **Other Municipal Services:** All other municipal services customarily provided to Village residents, including refuse contract eligibility, snow removal on accepted streets, and administrative services, shall be extended on the same basis as elsewhere in the Village.

This municipal services plan may be supplemented administratively as necessary to comply with law or operational requirements.
