

Municipal Income Tax Guide for Residents in the Village of Doylestown



In the State of Ohio municipal income taxes are created by the laws of each municipality. A 2.0% income tax is levied on the income of every person residing in, or earning or receiving income in, the Village of Doylestown. The Village allows a 100% tax credit for taxes paid to other cities and villages, up to 1.0%. The purpose of the Doylestown tax is to provide for essential municipal services and necessary capital improvements such as safety services, parks and recreation.

Municipal Tax in Doylestown is Levied On:



Residence Tax

Individuals that live in municipalities



Workplace Tax

Individuals that earn taxable income in municipalities



Net Profit Tax

Businesses that earn taxable income in municipalities

The Village's Partnership with RITA

- Doylestown utilizes the Regional Income Tax Agency (RITA) to assist with tax administration. By collaborating with neighboring municipalities, this shared service supports the village capitalizing on economies of scale; plus greater efficiencies, additional tax expertise, and secure on-line filing and payment resources for our residents and businesses.
- Formed in 1971 through the Regional Council of Governments, RITA is a governmental agency established under Chapter 167 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- RITA provides income tax collection and processing services for more than 400 of Ohio's municipalities and is the largest municipal income tax collection agency in the state.

Penalties for Not Filing Municipal Income Taxes

Penalties and interest will be charged for:

- Unpaid Tax
- Late Filing Penalty
- Interest on Unpaid Tax
